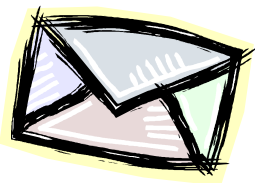
We need your help to repay the loan for the building of the Church.

WE NEED TO RAISE \$15,000 PER WEEK

Please share the responsibility for the building and the work of your Parish. We are asking from every working member of the Parish \$10 per week or \$500.00 per year.

Fundraising Initiatives

1. **Pledge Envelopes**: This has been very successful and very easy. Take a box from the Church or call the Parish Office. Place the envelope in the plate on Sunday, send by post or otherwise directly debit Savings or Credit Card Accounts fortnightly, monthly, quarterly or once a year.



Direct Debiting from a Visa or Mastercard Account is the easiest method as the chosen amount is automatically debited and is therefore effortless. To choose this method, complete the slip overleaf and mail back to the Parish Office or hand to one of the Priests. If every Parishioner donated \$10 a week we can easily repay our loan.

2. **Bricks**: Buy a brick for \$50. We used 21,000 Bricks to build the Church. Can you help us sell the remaining bricks?
3. **VMC Number Plates***: Be a proud member of the Community and purchase a Victorian Maronite Community Number plate for your car. Call Tania at the Parish House on 9480 2059. Once an order has been placed, documentation is sent to VicRoads on your behalf. VicRoads will courier the plates to your address within two weeks. At the special price of \$450 for one of the remaining Plates (up to 099), order yours today.
4. **Pews/Seats***: The finest quality timber was used to make the Church Pews / Seats. Sponsor one today for \$5,000. We still need to pay for 10 seats.
5. **New Church Windows**: Two new windows of St. Peter and St. Paul are to be made in Lebanon for our Church. The windows are \$20,000 each and we are seeking 400 donations of \$100. These windows will be in Memory of Monsignor Paul El-Khoury. Can you help by sponsoring \$100?
